Expectations

- Will be clean, tidy and off the face.
- Clips, ribbons, bands, must be of school colours. (bottle green, black, navy or white)
- Style to be appropriate for primary school wear. (fads or trends, e.g. mohawks, lettering, rats tails, spiking or similar are not permitted)
- Colouring is not permitted. (this includes streaking and tinting)

Make-up

Make up and nail polish are not to be worn.

Jewellery

 For safety reasons no jewellery is to be worn, with the exception of watches, medic bracelets and small, plain stud earrings.
