Learning in Term Three

Mathematics

We begin the term with measurement, moving towards algebra mid way through the term. Students will be exploring the multiple ways we measure, this includes measuring angles, time, temperature, weight, capacity & distance. Following this students will move onto learning about algebra. Our maths programme continues to be a combination of teaching sessions, workshops, independent practice and problem solving activities. Growing mathematical confidence continues to be a priority with an emphasis on engagement and enthusiasm being paramount.

Science: Forces, Flight and Motion

We are learning about energy in all its forms and how it is present in the world around us. We are integrating literacy by exploring this topic through reading comprehension activities.

Reading & Writing

Students will be writing their own picture books with an opportunity to read them to the junior school later in the term. Book Week is fast approaching where we will share the students underwater information reports as well as their picture books.

Physical Education, Health, & Technology

Our physical education programme has started with swimming lessons and later in the term students will choreograph a simple gymnastic routine to perform in the area. Students are

expected to have their PE gear at school Monday through Thursday. Technology at Avalon Intermediate School continues to be on Friday and we ask that all students bring a raincoat on Fridays in case of bad weather.

At the end of this term we will complete a health unit on sexuality education, with a focus on depth of knowledge about pubertal change. More detailed information will be sent home closer to this time.
